

Who is included in the Settlement Agreement Population^[1]?

The Settlement Agreement target population for housing includes Virginians with developmental disabilities at least 18 years of age or older who are in one of the following categories:

- Living in a training center, intermediate care facility, skilled nursing facility and eligible for one of the Medicaid DD Waivers
- Receiving Medicaid DD Waiver services
- On a waitlist for Medicaid DD Waiver services

If this sounds like you and you are interested in housing opportunities in the community, please join us for this information session!

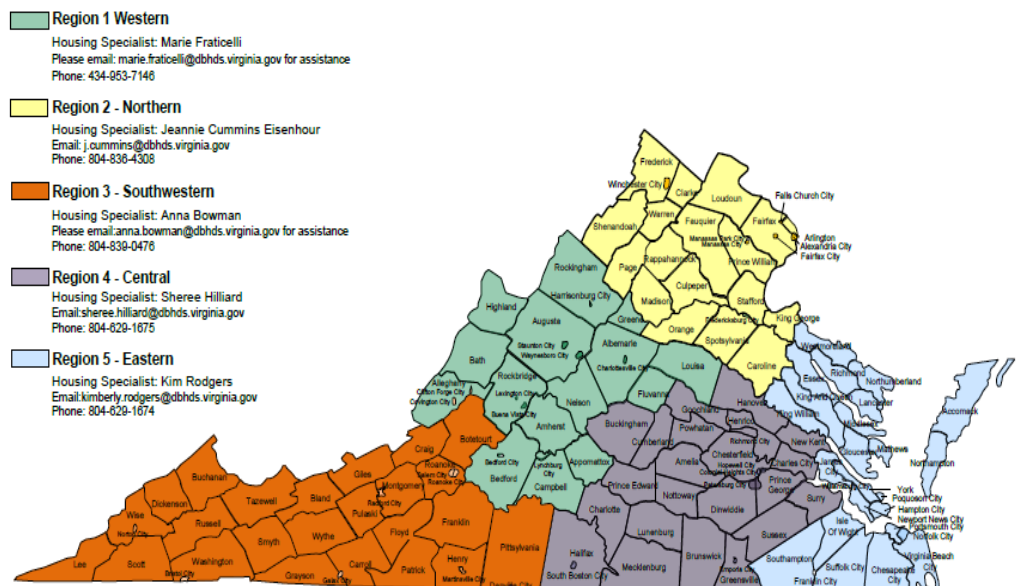
[1] The Commonwealth of Virginia entered into an agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice to create housing options for eligible individuals with DD in the community.
